Site Manager v4.2.0 Release Notes

1. Introduction

Site Manager v4.1.0 introduces alerts for Rotating Telehandlers, an embargo parameter for Pedestrian Proximity alerts, a Fuel Fob user view for your Smart Tanks, a new Smart Tank fob permission type and visibility of what fuel type is being used in your Smart Tank.

2. <u>Alerts for Rotating Telehandlers</u>


We have now introduced some alerts as well as data for our fleet of Rotating Telehandlers. Please see our appendix at the bottom which lists the alert types available for each of our machine types. Please note that capability does vary depending on the model of machine, our Manitou Vision models are the most advanced and are capable of reporting all the alert types in the appendix below.

3. Proximity Alert Embargo

3.1 We have introduced an embargo for Proximity alerts which works in the same way as that for the Seatbelt alerts. A value is entered in minutes within your Group settings and this will delay any Pedestrian Proximity alerts for this time period from the first engine start up of the day. This allows the Operator to conduct daily safety checks for their machine in this time period without triggering any Proximity alerts. Once this amount of time has passed, the Proximity alerts will generate as normal.

4. Fuel Fob Page

4.1 We have created a new page whereby a Group or Division level user can view all the users who have active fobs within their organisation. A table is displayed with their details, their Fob serial number and what Tanks it's authorised on. You can use the **Export to Excel** function to download a copy in Excel. If you have permission to view this page you will see a see a new option called **Fuel Fobs** in the menu at the top.



5. New Smart Tank Fob Permission Type

5.1 A new permission type has been created for Smart Tank Fobs known as **Customer Master Fuel Dispenser.** A fob user can be given this permission type so that they can dispense fuel from any Smart Tank that is on hire to their organisation.

6. Fuel Type Visibility

6.1 We have now added a new field to the dispense table to show what fuel type is being used in your Smart Tank – Diesel or HVO. If you need to get the Fuel Type changed please contact the Digital Services Team – digital@ardenthire.com.
